

## NON-COMPLIANCE

Where a student does not follow the dress code and is not exempted, the staff will :

Discuss the benefits and positive aspect of a dress code.

Contact the parent / caregiver.

Arrange for the student and their family to be counselled to address and resolve concerns.

The principal will determine if a student is eligible to attend school excursion in accordance with Regulation 36 (2) (a) (b) School Education Act 1999.



## MODIFICATIONS

Parents of students who for ethnic, religious or health reasons, may wish to modify the school dress code are required to discuss such modifications with the principal.

## INTRODUCTION

In accordance with the School Education Act 1999, Kelmscott PS has an established dress code for all students attending the school. This has been endorsed by the School Board. By enrolling your child in our school, you are entering into an agreement to abide by the Kelmscott PS Dress Code Policy.

Kindergarten students are highly encouraged to wear school uniform. For years PP- 6 uniform is compulsory.

## RATIONALE

We believe that a dress code:

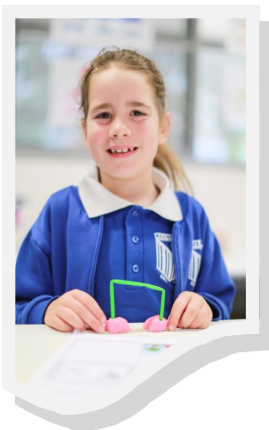
Fosters and enhances school pride and the public image of our school.

Encourages equity among students by reducing peer pressure.

Ensures students are safely and appropriately dressed for all school activities.

Prepares students for other situations in life where uniforms are necessary.

Provides a cost effective option for parents.



## SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school colours are royal blue, white and navy. Any combination of the following items is recognised as complying with the school dress code.

- ◆ Graduation polo shirt (Year 6)
- ◆ Royal blue polo shirt (white collar and white school crest)
- ◆ Navy skort
- ◆ Navy track pants
- ◆ Navy cargo pants or shorts
- ◆ Navy sports shorts
- ◆ Navy yoga pants
- ◆ Navy leggings (thigh length) (to be worn underneath skort / school dress, not on their own)
- ◆ Summer dress (blue and white check)
- ◆ Royal Blue zip jacket with white school crest
- ◆ Navy blue broad rimmed school hat or school bucket hat (white school crest)

## AVAILABILITY

Items in the designated school colours may be purchased from the School Clothing Pool.

When available, pre-loved clothing is available from the Clothing Pool.



## FURTHER INFORMATION

- ◆ Logos, slogans, motifs, stripes, patterns, jeans, denim or black clothing are not permitted.
- ◆ Children must wear school uniform when attending excursions/sporting events.
- ◆ For safety reasons, children should not wear any form of jewellery to school other than sleepers or stud earrings and watches.
- ◆ Makeup, including nail varnish, is prohibited.
- ◆ Appropriate footwear (such as sneakers) must be worn at all times for safety reasons. No backless, high heeled or platform shoes of any kind.
- ◆ We have a 'No hat, no sun' policy which means hats are to be worn at all times when outdoors.
- ◆ Shoulder length hair is to be tied back for health and safety reasons preferably using school coloured hair ties.
